Christa Longkumer writes ~ We had a great baptism with Toy (our friend) last weekend. Praise God and continue to remember her in prayer! We are leaving tomorrow for Bangkok to wait for our baby to arrive in a week or two! Please pray for an easy adjustment for Imti and that all will go well with the birth and delivery. We'll be in Bangkok for about a month to get baby's passport and other documents before we return to Laos the end of June.

Bible League prayer request ~ Nicaragua has been suffering from conflicts of pro-government groups and police against people opposed to the current power. President Daniel Ortega proposed a change in the social security system where many would have to put more funds into the national program. Bible League's ministry in Nicaragua was affected last week because people were afraid to get out of their homes. Just today I received an update from UnitedHealthcare Global who wrote, according to Nicaragua's Permanent Commission on Human Rights--at least 63 people were killed, more than 160 people were injured by gunfire and at least 15 people remain missing; the government has not yet confirmed or denied these numbers.
